Social Aspects of Tripyllia Figurines
Out of the ordinary? The anthropomorphic figurines of the
Cucuteni-Tripolye culture in the North-West Black Sea region
and their social background

This presentation would address the long-debated and still enigmatic problem of the large presence of anthropomorphic figurines in the Cucuteni-Tripolye Copper Age culture (5100 – 3000 BC). Are they unique? Are they ordinary? How and why do they occur? To which extent can we link them to the socio-economical dynamics of the Cucuteni-Tripolye culture? Why are figurines a key factor to solve the problem of mega-site formation in Eastern Europe? These are some of the questions I would try to respond in my presentation.
