

AetG2017 Practical Instructions

Conference participants are advised to fly to Hamburg International Airport (HAM). Here they can take the **KielExx** taxi (<http://www.vineta.net/airport/kielexx.php>) to Kiel, which will take an hour. Alternatively, the **Kielius** bus (https://www.bahn.de/autokraft/view/angebot/kielius_en/kielius-ueb-eng.shtml) takes an hour-and-a-half and is a bit cheaper.

On Wednesday between 1200 and 1800, registration is possible in the library of the Institut für Ur- und Frühgeschichte, Johanna-Mestorf-Straße, 24106 Kiel (see map). After registration a keynote lecture will be delivered by Prof. Dr. Johannes Müller in the Johanna Mestorf Hörsaal, in the same building, ending with an ice breaker/wine reception in the library.

On Thursday, Friday and Saturday morning the conference will take place at Leibnizstrasse 1, room 105 (1st floor). Coffee, tea and lunch will be provided here.

The conference dinner at Legienhof will be held on Thursday evening and is optional. Registration will be asked for a week before the conference takes place.

At Friday evening an informal gathering is planned at the Graduate School Human Development in Landscapes (Leibnizstrasse 3, 1st floor).

An excursion is planned for Saturday afternoon, when we will visit the Steinzeitdorf Dithmarschen in Albersdorf. On Sunday morning, a second excursion is planned for the Schloss Gottorf museum in Schleswig or people can already travel back to where they came.
